SAY WHAT?!

Sound play gives children the foundation for phonetics and language development. Rhyming, counting syllables, and counting speech sounds are one way we do this!

With your students, try sounding out the pronunciation of some of the foods you see here and identifying graphemes: radish, cantaloupe.

Count the syllables in each produce item: wa/ter/mel/on, zu/cchi/ni, and pe/ppers.

Ask students to list words that rhyme: tomato, potato, and alfredo!




